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| <i>Acacia glaucoptera</i> | Shrub; Clay Wattle; SW WA; 1.5m h; Evergreen compact wattle with blue-green, winged phyllodes edged red. It produces bright golden, globular flower clusters along the stems; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Alyogyne huegelii</i> 'West Coast Gem' | Shrub; Lilac Hibiscus; 2m h x 1.5m w; Evergreen. This native hibiscus has large, deep mauve open flowers all year, particularly Spring-Autumn. Hardy to moderate frosts. Prune to keep shapely; Sun; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Alyogyne huegelii</i> x <i>A. hakeifolia</i> 'Aussie Purple' | Shrub; 2m h; A fast-growing, evergreen shrub featuring deeply lobed foliage and large, vivid purple hibiscus-like flowers. Ideal for low maintenance gardens. Prune lightly to maintain shape and encourage flowering; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Anigozanthos</i> 'Yellow Gem' | Perennial; Kangaroo Paw; WA; 1 - 2m h x 0.5 - 1m w; Grass-like leaves and multi branched flowers stems with long lasting yellow flowers. Fast growing plant, forming clumps; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Archirhodomyrtus beckleri</i> | Tree; Rose Myrtle; E NSW & Qld; 2 - 4m h; Attractive, large plant with shiny foliage, smothered with perfumed shell-pink flowers followed by orange-red berries. Suitable for hedges and containers. Prune to keep bushy; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Atriplex cinerea</i> | Shrub; Coast Saltbush; 1 - 2m h; Evergreen. Attractive silver-grey foliage suitable for a low hedge. Useful in control of soil erosion; Flowers: Spring/Autumn; Sun; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Austrostipa stipoides</i> | Perennial; SE Aus, NZ; 0.6 - 1m h; A hardy, tufted grass that thrives in sandy or rocky coastal soils. Flowering straw-coloured spikelets appear in Spring; Sun; Well-drained |
| <i>Backhousia leptopetala</i> | Tree; Brown Myrtle; Qld, NSW; 12m h; (syn. <i>Choricarpia leptopetala</i>). Evergreen, leathery, aromatic, dark green leaves tinted bronze when new. It produces clusters of small, cream to white flowers with narrow, fringed petals that give a delicate, feathery appearance. Suitable to hedge; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun; Moist/Well-drained |
| <i>Banksia marginata</i> | Shrub; Silver Banksia; SE Aus; 2m h; A variable shrub or small tree ranging from 1 - 12m but typically around 2m. It has narrow leaves that have distinctive silver undersides and golden cylindrical flower spikes that attract birds and insects. Hardy and adaptable, tolerating poor soils; Flowers: Summer/Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Bauera rubioides</i> (deep-pink flowers) | Shrub; River Rose; SE Aus; 0.5 - 1.5m h; A bushy plant with small, shiny leaves and deep pink, bell-like flowers with a mass of yellow stamens in the centre. Trim lightly in Spring or after flowering if required; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Semi Shade; Moist |
| <i>Boronia filifolia</i> | Shrub; Slender Boronia; SE S Aus; 0.5 - 0.75m h; A low spreading plant with narrow, aromatic foliage and delicate pink, star-shaped flowers. Prune after flowering; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Brachychiton acerifolius</i> | Tree; Illawarra Flame Tree; E Aus; 10 - 20m h; Evergreen. Red flowers from November-February making a spectacular display at Christmas. Very adaptable to most sites, prefers good drainage when young; Sun; Well-drained |
| <i>Calothamnus lateralis</i> | Shrub; SW WA; 0.4 - 1.5m h; Erect, spreading shrub with needle-like leaves and clusters of one-sided red flowers, followed by woody capsules. Grows in swampy areas. Attracts birds and bees; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Adaptable |
| <i>Chamelaucium uncinatum</i> (deep pink) | Shrub; Geraldton Wax; 1.5 - 2.5m h; A dense, spreading shrub with long-lasting deep pink waxy flowers. Fine, aromatic foliage adds year-round appeal. Popular as a cut flower. Trim after flowering. Light frost tolerance; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |

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| <i>Chamelaucium uncinatum</i> (large flower form) | Shrub; Geraldton Wax; WA; Small to medium shrub with showy open five petalled pink flowers of waxy texture; Flowers: Spring; Sun; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Chorilaena quercifolia</i> | Shrub; SW WA; 1 - 3m h x 1 - 2m w; Very floriferous with furry oak-shaped leaves and red ageing to cream, small, pendulous flowers. A useful understorey or screen plant, moderately frost tolerant. Bird attracting, Responds well to pruning; Flowers: Spring to Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Chorilaena quercifolia</i> (red flower) | Shrub; WA; 1 - 2.5m h; A striking deciduous plant valued for its large, lobed, oak-like leaves and bold red blooms. The flowers appear in cone-shaped clusters, adding vibrant colour and texture. Ideal for borders or hedging. Attracts birds and pollinators; Flowers: Spring to Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Chorizema cordatum</i> | Shrub; Flame Pea; WA; 1m h; Scrambling shrub with leathery, dark green, heart-shaped leaves. Brilliant orange-red pea flowers. Will act as climber if given support. Prune after flowering to maintain compact growth; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Semi Shade; Moist/Well-drained |
| <i>Chorizema cordatum</i> x <i>varium</i> | Climber; Heart-leaved Flame Pea; SW WA; 1 - 2m h x 1 - 2m w; A dense shrub or semi-climber, with many slender branches, small pea-shaped flowers borne in terminal racemes, coloured orange, pink and yellow, sporadically throughout the year. Prune after flowering; Semi Shade; Moist/Well-drained |
| <i>Chrysocephalum apiculatum</i> | Perennial; Everlasting Yellow Buttons; 0.2 - 0.6m h x 0.8m w; A native ground cover featuring silvery-grey, woolly foliage and bright yellow button clusters. Hardy to moderate frost. Excellent for cut and dried flowers; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Chrysocephalum apiculatum</i> 'Yorke Peninsula' | Perennial; 0.15 - 0.3m h; A low growing evergreen plant with silvery, soft foliage and golden yellow, button-like flowers. Suitable for rockeries, containers and hanging baskets. Tolerant of frost and salt; Flowers: Spring to Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Coronidium elatum</i> | Shrub; White Paper Daisy; 0.6 - 2m h x 1m w; (syn. <i>Helichrysum elatum</i>) Herbaceous, woody shrub with abundant, white daisy-like flowers and silver-green foliage. Flowers can be used in dried arrangements. Prune to keep compact. Tolerates light frost; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Correa</i> 'Mallee Pastel' | Shrub; 0.3m h x 1m w; A small ground cover with unusual bell-shaped pastel pink flowers; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Correa alba</i> (pink form) | Shrub; SE Aus; 0.5 - 1m h x 1m w; Pale pink flowers spring-autumn. Spreading hardy coastal plant used by early settlers as a tea substitute. Greyish leaves. Tolerates salt spray, is frost hardy and bird attracting; Sun/Semi-shade; Moist/Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Correa alba</i> var <i>pannosa</i> | Shrub; Velvet White Correa; Vic; 0.5m h; Hardy small hybrid shrub. Vigorous low grower, forming a dense carpet. Flowers blush-pink centres to white star-shaped blooms. Good for borders; Flowers: Autumn/Winter; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Correa glabra</i> | Shrub; Rock Correa; E Aus; 1 - 2m h x 2m w; Yellow/green bell-shaped flowers. Valuable as a screen plant and for soil binding/erosion. Attracts birds. Frost hardy; Flowers: Autumn/Winter; Sun/Semi-shade; Adaptable; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Correa glabra</i> 'Coliban River' | Shrub; 1 - 1.5m h x 1.8m w; A compact shrub with glossy green foliage and a dense habit. It bears pendulous, soft green to yellow tubular flowers attracting nectar-feeding birds, and is drought tolerant and light frost tolerant once established; Flowers: Autumn/Winter; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Correa glabra</i> (variegated form) | Shrub; Vic; 0.5m h x 0.5m w; Hardy correa with light green variegated foliage and mid-pink tubular flowers. Low spreader; Flowers: Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |

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| <i>Correa reflexa</i> | Shrub; S & E Aus; 0.5 - 1.5m h; Small spreading evergreen shrub. Red tubular flowers with yellow-green tips that are turned back or reflexed, with 8 slightly protruding stamens tipped with yellow anthers; Flowers: Autumn/Winter; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Correa reflexa</i> (Kangaroo Island form) | Shrub; SA; 1 - 1.5m h x 1 - 1.5m w; Tubular red flowers with green tips. Smallish shrub with small narrow, rounded leaves. Can be pruned and used as a hedge; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Crowea 'Poorinda Ecstasy'</i> | Shrub; 0.8m h; Compact evergreen cultivar with light green aromatic leaves and pink star-shaped flowers Performs well in pots. Trim beneficial. Frost tolerant; Flowers: Spring to Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Crowea exalata 'Ryan's Star'</i> | Shrub; 0.6m h x 0.8m w; Compact, evergreen plant with fine, aromatic foliage and masses of star-shaped, deep pink flowers. Attracts pollinators, drought and frost tolerant. Light pruning after flowering maintains shape; Flowers: Autumn/Winter; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Crowea exalata 'Southern Star'</i> | Shrub; 0.6m h x 0.6m w; Small rounded shrub with masses of small star shaped pink flowers. Frost tolerant; Flowers: Autumn/Winter; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Darwinia taxifolia</i> var. <i>macrolaena</i> | Shrub; NSW; 0.2 - 0.5m h x 1m w; Prostrate, small shrub with grey-green leaves; large pink and red flower heads. Ideal for containers, and as groundcover for embankments. Tolerates short periods of dryness once established. Prune after flowering; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Moist/Well-drained |
| <i>Dendrobium 'Ellen Rau'</i> | Orchid; 0.3m h; Rock orchid. Clusters of soft mauve flowers with spotted strong mauve tips. Reverse of petals strong mauve. Very early flowering in July. Hardy outdoors in Melbourne. Protect from summer sun and hot winds. Ideal on tree ferns or rocks; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Semi Shade; Well-drained; Frost Tender |
| <i>Dendrobium kingianum</i> | Orchid; Epiphytic. Flowers are pale to deep pink. Does well outside in pots or baskets; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Dendrobium kingianum</i> '(Yonda x Ellen) X Aussie Bonanza' | Orchid; Upright racemes of white/mauve flowers in late Winter/Spring. Keep dry in Winter; Semi Shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Dendrobium kingianum</i> hybrid | Orchid; Pink Rock Orchid; E Aus; Dainty vanilla scented flowers in a range of colours of deep to light pink. Epiphytic. 50% shade summer/full sun winter. Excellent if fastened to tree branches; Flowers: Spring; Semi Shade; Well-drained; Frost Tender |
| <i>Derwentia arenaria</i> | Perennial; SE Qld, N NSW; 0.3 - 0.5m h; (syn. <i>Veronica arenaria</i>) Spectacular small multiple stemmed plant with long racemes of colourful flowers that vary from pale violet blue to deep violet blue; frost hardy; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Enchylaena tomentosa</i> | Shrub; Ruby Saltbush; 0.5 - 1m h; Small, evergreen spreading plant with semi-succulent, grey-green leaves, insignificant flowers, followed by showy berries turning red when ripe. Used in revegetation and erosion control; Flowers: Spring to Autumn; Sun; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Epacris calvertiana</i> var. <i>versicolor</i> | Shrub; NSW; 1.2m h; Flowers usually 5-7mm diameter, the tube pink to red and lobes, white or cream; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Semi Shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Epacris impressa</i> (pink) | Shrub; SE Aus; 0.3 - 1m h; A slender evergreen shrub with attractive, tubular pink flowers. Attracts honeyeaters, frost tolerant, and serves as Victoria's floral emblem. Excellent cut flower and suitable for containers; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Eremophila 'Meringur Midnight'</i> | Shrub; 3 - 4m h x 2 - 3m w; A graceful, large shrub with weeping foliage and deep, elongated purple flowers. Can be regularly pruned to keep at desired height. Drought and frost hardy once established; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun; Well-drained |

- Eremophila alternifolia x maculata* Shrub; 1.2m h x 1.5m w; Narrow green foliage with pink-magenta tubular flowers that have a spotted throat. Frost tolerant. Prune after flowering. Drought tolerant once established; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Adaptable
- Eremophila glabra 'Kalbarri Carpet'* Shrub; 0.2m h x 1m w; Lovely groundcover with silver leaves and yellow-gold flowers in small narrow tubes with extended lip. Tolerates light frost. Attracts birds; Flowers: Spring to Autumn; Sun; Well-drained
- Eremophila glabra 'Roseworthy'* Shrub; Common Emu Bush; 0.3m h x 1.5m w; Excellent, hardy, flat ground cover with tiny green leaves and tubular yellow to red flowers. Lightly prune. Bird attracting. Suitable for containers; Flowers: Spring to Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant
- Eremophila glabra x maculata* Shrub; 0.8 - 1.2m h x 1.5m w; A compact shrub with green foliage and red, tubular flowers. Can be pruned hard; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun; Well-drained; Adaptable
- Eremophila maculata ssp. maculata* Shrub; 1 - 2m h; A hardy, upright to spreading shrub with grey-green leaves and tubular flowers, usually red or pink with darker spotted throats. Native to arid inland regions, it is drought and frost tolerant and attracts nectar feeding birds. Can be lightly pruned.; Sun; Well-drained
- Gastrolobium praemorsum 'Bronze Butterfly'* Shrub; SW Aus; 0.5m h; Prostrate ground cover, creeper, or small shrub. Oval leaves with truncated tips, dark green above and silky underneath. Red pea flowers from Winter to Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained
- Goodenia macmillanii* Shrub; Pinnate Goodenia; Vic; 0.3 - 0.6m h; Beautiful, rare, and unusual small erect shrub. Ovate tooth-edged bright green leaves, purple/mauve flowers. Tolerates sandy loam or clay. Good in rockeries or pots; Flowers: Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Moist
- Goodenia ovata* Shrub; Hop Goodenia; 1 - 2m h x 1.5m w; Yellow flowers. Will grow in wet soils. Moderately frost hardy; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant
- Graptophyllum excelsum* Shrub; CE Aus; 1.5 - 3m h x 1.5 - 2m w; Evergreen. Showy and profuse deep red tubular flowers. Upright habit, suitable for narrow sites. Tolerant of lime and light frosts. Attracts birds; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Moist/Well-drained
- Grevillea 'Lemon Supreme'* Shrub; 1.5m h x 1.5m w; Hybrid grevillea with soft, small holly shaped olive green foliage and open rounded flowers of strong lemon colour; Flowers: Spring; Sun; Well-drained
- Grevillea chrysophaea* Shrub; Golden Grevillea; Vic; 0.3 - 2.5m h; A spreading or occasionally prostrate shrub. Leaves are elliptical to linear. Flowers range in colour from dull to golden yellow, with a red to orange-red style; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained
- Grevillea crithmifolia* Shrub; SW WA; 0.5 - 1.5m h; A dense, spreading plant with finely divided, soft green foliage and masses of white to pale pink spider-like flowers. Attracts birds and insects; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun; Well-drained
- Grevillea dimorpha* Shrub; Flame Grevillea; The Grampians; 1 - 2m h x 1.5m w; (syn. *Grevillea speciosa* ssp. *dimorpha*). Bright red flowers most of the year and narrow, stiff dark green leaves. Bird attracting and moderately frost hardy; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Acidic
- Grevillea gariwerdensis* Shrub; Spider Flower; Vic (Grampians); 1m h x 1m w; Gariwerdensis is the original Koori name of the Grampians area. Has pink flowers and interesting wiry foliage. Hardy to moderate frosts. Rare; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Semi Shade; Well-drained; Acidic
- Grevillea lanigera* Shrub; Woolly Grevillea; SE Aus; 0.2 - 0.3m h x 1 - 1.5m w; Prostrate. Spreading, groundcover plant with profuse pink/red flowers almost all year. Prefers good drainage but is very adaptable. Frost hardy. Useful on banks. Attracts birds; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun; Well-drained; Acidic; Drought Tolerant

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| <i>Grevillea lanigera (prostrate)</i> | Shrub; SE Aus; 0.3m h x 1.5m w; Attractive, low dense groundcover. Narrow, grey-green round tipped leaves that are soft and woolly. Flowers are red to pinkish-cream in spider-like clusters. Frost and drought tolerant; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Grevillea nudiflora 'Mallee Sensation'</i> | Shrub; 0.3m h x 1 - 2m w; A vigorous, hardy, prostrate plant forming a dense groundcover of fine green foliage that takes on bronzy tones in cooler months. The abundant spider-shaped bright red flowers attract birds and insects. Responds to pruning; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Grevillea rosmarinifolia x mucronulata</i> | Shrub; 3m h x 3m w; Vigorous hybrid shrub with linear-lanceolate leaves, scattered small red spidery flowers, that attract birds, throughout the year, but mainly from May to December; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Grevillea victoriae subsp.nivalis</i> | Shrub; Mt Kosciuszko; 0.2 - 4m h; Dwarf to medium shrub with grey-green, lanceolate leaves and pendent clusters of red, spider-like flowers with yellow-tipped anthers; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Guichenotia macrantha</i> | Shrub; Large-flowered Guichenotia; WA; 0.2 - 1.5m h; Small, erect shrub with densely hairy young shoots. Striking pinkish-purple flowers about 2.5cm wide. A good cut flower; suitable for growing under eucalyptus; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Semi Shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Hakea clavata</i> | Shrub; S WA; 0.5 - 2m h; A spreading shrub forming a dense rounded mound with distinctive clavate leaves that are thick, leathery and bluish-green. Clusters of pale pink to white flowers nestle along older wood, offering nectar for birds and insects. Excellent for coastal gardens; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Hibbertia grossulariifolia</i> | Shrub; Qld, NSW; 0.2m h x 1m w; Prostrate plant with red hairy stems, dark, glossy-green, deeply-lobed leaves and bright yellow flowers; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Hibbertia scandens</i> | Climber; Snake Vine; N Aus; Large open yellow flowers most of the year and attractive, evergreen, glossy foliage. Good soil binder. Can be used as groundcover. Tolerates moderate frost. Salt tolerant; Sun; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Hibbertia sericea</i> | Shrub; Silky Guinea Flower; SE Aus; 0.3 - 0.7m h; A variable, small, low-growing shrub with slender, spreading stems and soft, silvery-hairy foliage. It produces bright yellow, five-petaled flowers, often in abundance. Attracts pollinators; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Hibbertia truncata</i> | Shrub; Vic; 0.2 - 0.3m h x 0.5 - 1.5m w; Ground cover, can be a climber. Showy, coastal plant with small yellow flowers. Tolerates moderate frosts. Lime tolerant; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Hibiscus heterophyllus (apricot/yellow)</i> | Shrub; NE Aus; 3 - 5m h; Evergreen, fast growing plant with large, single, apricot/yellow flowers with a dark centre. Prune to keep compact. Tolerates light frost; Flowers: Summer; Sun; Well-drained |
| <i>Homoranthus flavescens</i> | Shrub; E Aus; 0.2 - 0.4m h x 0.6 - 1.5m w; Prostrate growing, beautiful grey-green flat-topped foliage plant. Aromatic foliage and pale-yellow flowers. Bird attracting and frost hardy; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Hoya australis</i> | Climber; Wax Flower; N Aus; 6m h; A hardy, evergreen climber with long twining stems of fleshy glossy leaves, bearing spectacular round clusters of sweetly scented, white, waxy flowers. Can be grown indoors in a well lit area. Light frost tolerance; Flowers: Summer/Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Hoya macgillivrayi</i> | Climber; NE Aus; 4 - 6m h; Fragrant, burgundy flowers up to 6cm wide in clusters; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Semi Shade; Well-drained |

Agave attenuata

Succulent; Mexico; 1.2m h x 1m w; 2m spike of cream flowers. Blooms once after many years. Handsome, sculptural plant with large rosettes of broad, smooth, pliant leaves with no terminal spine; Sun; Well-drained; Frost Tender

Agave filifera

Succulent; Thread Agave; Mexico; 0.5m h x 0.5m w; Perennial succulent with narrow green leaves, spined at the tip. White leaf margins gradually break away, leaving long white fibres. Yellow-green flowers on a 2.5m tall stem; Flowers: Summer; Sun; Well-drained

Agave franzosinii 'Grey Ghost'

Succulent; 2.5m h x 3m w; (syn. *A. beauleriana*) Large succulent, bluish-grey, undulating, and bending leaves in a single rosette. Leaves have large teeth on the margins. Very infrequent yellow flowers. Dies after flowering but easily propagated from rhizomes; Sun; Well-drained

Agave gypsophila

Succulent; Mexico; 1m h x 1m w; A good feature plant with grey, wavy leaves edged with sharp spines. Spectacular tufts of golden tubular flowers held at the ends of alternate branches along a 2m flower spike. Suits garden or pots; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Frost Tender

Agave nickelsiae

Succulent; Mexico; 0.6m h; Slow-growing succulent with stiff, dark green leaves strikingly marked in white, with black spikes at tips. After 15-20 yrs, the flower panicle atop very tall stems has green/white blooms of 3 petals, tinged purple with purple stripes down the centre; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained

Agave parryi

Succulent; Arizona, Mexico; 0.3 - 0.6m h; Grey-blue leaves in a dense, compact basal rosette. Erect panicles of creamy yellow flowers, pink-tinged in bud, are held on a spike 5m high; Flowers: Summer; Sun; Dry; Drought Tolerant

Agave schottii

Succulent; Schott's Century; Mexico; 0.45m h x 0.6m w; Grows on rocky slopes in individual green to yellow-green rosettes, with very spiny leaves and slender curling hairs. Tall flower spike with pleasantly scented, yellow-green flowers; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Dry; Drought Tolerant

Agave titanota

Succulent; Mexico; 0.3 - 0.6m h; A medium-sized agave that is very robust looking and forms a mostly solitary rosette with a wide-open crown of a few leaves up to 75cm in diameter. Leaf margins are lined with teeth. Flowers on a tall stalk once in its lifetime; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained

Agave victoriae-reginae

Succulent; NE Mexico; 0.2m h; Small, compact rosettes of short, rigid, thick, dark green leaves with a pattern of white markings. Slow-growing for 20-30 years. After many years has a flower spike of over 2m high, usually of purple-red colours; Flowers: Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained

Ajanía pacífica

Shrub; C&E Asia; 0.4m h x 0.45m w; (syn. *Chrysanthemum pacificum*). Mound forming excellent ground cover. Very attractive lobed, grey-green leaves, silver-edged. Clusters of yellow button flowers. Prune hard in late winter; Flowers: Autumn; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained

Aloe 'Boris'

Succulent; 0.08m h x 0.08m w; Small growing plant with bright green spotted lanceolate leaves, edged with soft teeth. Orange-red bulbous bell flowers grow at the tips of delicate curved stems. Plant forms offsets from the base and flushes bronze in extreme hot or cold; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained

| <i>Tillandsia kirchoffiana</i> | Bromeliad; 1m h; Long, fine green leaves bearing red floral bracts and lavender diurnal flowers; Flowers: Summer; Semi Shade; Moist/Well-drained |
| <i>Tillandsia multicaulis</i> | Bromeliad; C America, Mexico; 0.4m h; This epiphytic species has medium green leaves arranged in rosettes. Multiple spikes produce orange bracts with purple petals and greenish-white sepals; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Semi Shade |
| <i>Tillandsia philippo-coburgi</i> | Bromeliad; Brazil; 0.4m h; (syn. <i>Vriesea philippo-coburgi</i>) Light, glossy green foliage with purple tips and a tall red and yellow flower spike 1-3m high; Flowers: Winter; Semi Shade |
| <i>Trachelospermum asiaticum</i> | Climber; Asia; Evergreen groundcover or climber, with dark glossy green leaves and fragrant yellow-white star-like flowers. Ideal for covering walls or fences. Hardy; Flowers: Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| <i>Trachelospermum jasminoides</i> (prostrate form) | Climber; China; Dark, shining green leaves, with crinkled edges. Small white flowers. Good highly fragrant ground cover; Flowers: Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Veltheimia bracteata</i> | Bulb; Veldt Lily; S Africa; 0.35m h; Semi-evergreen. Spikes of green-tipped, rosy-pink bells. Large shining leaves. Light frost tolerance; Flowers: Winter/Spring; Shade |
| <i>Veronica bollonsii</i> | Shrub; NZ; 1.5m h; (syn. <i>Hebe bollonsii</i>) Evergreen bushy shrub with dark green, glossy to oblong leaves and spikes of tiny white to pale purple flowers up to 15cm long; Flowers: Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Vriesea</i> 'Purple Cockatoo' | Bromeliad; 0.3m h; (Hybrid cultivar of <i>V. barilletii</i> x <i>erthrodactylon</i>) Bright green leaves with a short-stemmed red splaying flower head; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Shade; Dry |
| <i>Vriesea guttata</i> | Bromeliad; Brazil; 0.2m h x 0.2m w; A long pendulous pink flower bract (30cm); blood-red/rusty brown mottles form horizontal markings on the leaves. Ideal for hanging baskets; Flowers: Spring; Shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Weigela</i> (Lemoine hybrid, white) | Shrub; 2m h x 2m w; Deciduous. White flowers. Prune out some old branches after flowering to maintain vigour. Rarely cultivated variety; Flowers: Spring; Sun; Moist/Well-drained |
| <i>Weigela florida</i> 'Bristol Ruby' | Shrub; 2 - 3m h x 1.5m w; Deciduous, medium rich-green shrub with erect, rounded habit and fragrant, tubular ruby-red, long-lasting flowers. Good for cutting; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| <i>Weigela florida</i> 'Variegata' | Shrub; Korea/N China; 2m h x 2m w; Compact shrub with rose-coloured flowers and cream-edged leaves; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun; Well-drained |
| <i>Weigela subsessilis</i> | Shrub; Korea; 1.5m h x 1.5m w; Deciduous, bushy, dense plant. Funnel-shaped, yellow flowers sometimes flushed pink. Rare; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade |
| x <i>Gasterhaworthia</i> 'Coolill' | Succulent; 0.35m h; Rosette (70mm) of reddish green leaves with small white spots edged with fine teeth; Sun; Well-drained |
| X <i>Pachyveria clavifolia</i> | Succulent; 0.15m h; (<i>Pachyphytum</i> x <i>Echeveria</i>) Upright plant with elongated grey leaves, spiralling densely around the stem. Offsets readily form dense clumps. Orange/pink bells hang off hooked stems; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
| X <i>Sedeveria</i> 'Darley Dale' | Succulent; Rosette form with 30-40 narrow, mid-green leaves. Produces offsets readily; Flowers: Spring/Summer; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained; Drought Tolerant |
| X <i>Sedeveria</i> 'El Aquinet' | Succulent; Leaves form small rosettes, with keeled, pointed bright green leaves, and masses of flowers. Good in rockeries; Flowers: Spring; Sun/Semi-shade; Well-drained |
